

Projected Profits:

The attached projections will give you an idea of what could be made in profits from quilting. Please note, this prices will vary by your location. The amount of time spent on each quilt will also vary based on technique and the skill and experience of the quilter.

The projection also varies based on whether the quilting is hand-guided or computerized. With a Gammill Vision 2.0, the machine is hand guided by the individual. The hours estimated are when the machine is being guided by the quilter. The Statler Stitcher provides a computerized option (although it can also be used in hand-guided mode).

Also, please note the time listed is for quilting. There will be additional time spent preparing and loading the quilt. These numbers were estimated based on individuals who have been in business for at least two years. Like most businesses, the first few years can be "building years." Other Fees:

Batting and Thread: You may wish to charge for thread and batting. This can provide additional profit, depending on your charge. This also ensures you have quality materials to work with.

Additional fees and examples of charges:

Seaming a backing: \$5/seam

Pressing: \$15/hour

Binding: \$25 to make and apply

Hand bind on back: \$65 for queen size

Cleaning threads from back of quilt: \$15/hour
